Consultation Clinics

Clinicians from CAMHS Connect will be available for consultation on a regular basis in your area. If you are concerned about a young person and need some help and guidance, you may find it beneficial to sit down with us and explore what is going on for the young person and what might be helpful next steps. Consultations provide the opportunity to formulate about a young person's social and emotional well-being, and discuss ideas for interventions and/or signposting to services that may help.

We aim to support you in thinking and linking about the young person and family, including considering the possible impact of adverse childhood experiences, trauma, environmental, attachment and emotional wellbeing and mental health difficulties.
