

SIXTH FORM PROSPECTUS UPDATE for SEPTEMBER 2017

INTRODUCTION

Recent governmental changes to Key Stage 5 study mean that the information in the main prospectus is out of date. We are developing a new prospectus in conjunction with our academy trust, but we could not achieve this in time for the next academic year. We have produced this update as an interim measure to help with your decision making.

KEY DIFFERENCES:

- Students must achieve a minimum of 5 GCSEs at grade C or above (grade 5 in English and Maths), plus the required entry grade for the subjects they wish to study
- We no longer offer Level 2 courses, except for those students who achieve sufficient grades to attend Sixth Form but need to resit English or Maths GCSE alongside their other study
- All A Levels are now **two year linear courses** with final exams at the end of Year 13
- Students will now study **three** courses through Year 12 and 13, instead of starting on four and dropping one (we will consider students who wish to study four if there is academic evidence to support potential success)
- Vocational courses all now contain formal exam units

COURSE LIST

IMPORTANT NOTE

It is our aim to provide the broadest choice of courses possible but our ability to run a course is dependent on several factors, most importantly student numbers.

All courses are subject to change and **some may not run at all**. To facilitate the widest chance of studying with us, we ask students to choose a reserve subject in case one of their initial choices is not possible.
