Vehicle Safety on KSA premises.

There is an increasing number of parents who are in the habit of coming onto the Academy site to collect their children at 15:10 and this is becoming a hazardous situation. There are now so many cars entering the gates that a queue forms out on to Gainsborough Rd. The Police have complained about this and the Academy bus often has no way of getting to the bus bay as it is full of waiting cars.

As a result, the safeguarding of the students is becoming hard to manage, as our traffic management policy is being flaunted by those coming in with no genuine need. The increase in traffic flow heightens the danger to the children and there have been a couple of near misses that we are no longer willing to tolerate.

Parents of children that have a special requirement to be collected directly from the Academy will be allowed to enter, but others are requested to make arrangements to collect your child at a safe spot outside of the school grounds.

It is crucial for student safety that all parents read and understand this message. We expect all parents to abide by our vehicle safety plan when on site and to follow these guidelines.

Over the next few weeks, Site Staff will be monitoring the situation and reminding parents of our requirements;

- The speed limit is 10 mph
- Do not stop just inside the gates in the middle of the road, continue as far round the island as you can and then drop off, there are pavements throughout.
- Do not park up in the bus bay, if coming into school use a dedicated parking bay, even if it is round the side of the school.
