Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to you to inform about the changes to our current PSHE curriculum.

As part of your child's education in Kingswood Secondary Academy, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. We believe that PSHE is an important curriculum which prepares and equips our young people to lead safe, healthy and productive lives and meet their full potential. We teach this to every year group in form time, assemblies, workshops and speakers to ensure our students have a developed understanding of issues which may affect them later in life. All PSHE teaching takes place in a safe learning environment and is underpinned by our school mission and values. Our school follows the award-winning Jigsaw programme which provides us with a comprehensive, robust scheme of work bringing consistency and progression to our students' learning in this important curriculum area.

You may or may not be aware, that due to Government legislation, ALL schools in the UK will be required to offer Sex and Relationship Education to all students as part of a fully comprehensive Personal, Social and Health Education curriculum from September 2020. In line with the Department of Education recommendations and statutory requirements Kingswood and many schools across the UK launched the new amendments in September 2020.
